CIRCULAR TO DEPARTMENTS AND AUTHORITIES NO. 4 OF 2004

WITHDRAWAL OF CIRCULAR 11 OF 1973: GOVERNMENT WAGES EMPLOYEES NORTH OF 26TH PARALLEL RECREATIONAL LEAVE – FARE CONCESSIONS

I refer to Industrial Employees' Circular No.11 of 1973, which provides a recreational leave fare concession for Government wages employees employed north of the 26th parallel.

Please be advised that Circular 11 of 1973 has been withdrawn, effective from the date of this circular. As a consequence, Circular 16 of 1973 and Circular 1 of 1974 have also been withdrawn, effective from the same date.

Agencies should apply fare concessions (annual leave travel concession) in accordance with relevant awards and/or industrial agreements.
