## STATUTORY PUBLIC HOLIDAYS FOR 2008 AND NEW YEAR 2009

Under the provisions of the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1972*, the following dates are public holidays during 2008 and over the New Year period 2009.

New Year's Day

Australia Day

Labour Day

Good Friday

Easter Monday

Tuesday 1 January 2008

Monday 28 January 2008

Monday 3 March 2008

Friday 21 March 2008

Monday 24 March 2008

Anzac Day Friday 25 April 2008

Queen's Birthday\* Monday 29 September 2008
Christmas Day Thursday 25 December 2008

New Year's Day Thursday 1 January 2009

## NOTE:

Easter Tuesday and the extra day after New Year's Day are no longer public service holidays. Employees, who would have otherwise received the benefit of repealed public service holidays, are able to take two days' paid leave of absence in lieu of the repealed public service holidays. The two additional days paid at the rate of ordinary time, can be added to annual leave or taken individually but must be taken in the year in which they occur. Under no circumstances should these days be allowed to accrue. (Please refer to Premier's Circular 1 of 2003 issued by the Department of the Premier and Cabinet).
