CIRCULAR TO DEPARTMENTS AND AUTHORITIES NO. 7 OF 1992

WORKERS' COMPENSATION CLAIMS - EFFECT ON EMPLOYEES SEEKING VOLUNTARY SEVERANCE

In a memo to all Chief Executive Officers dated 25 October 1991, the Director General, Ministry of the Premier and Cabinet advised that the Government had reviewed the policy applying to employees with outstanding workers' compensation claims who were also seeking severance under the Special Voluntary Severance Officer 1991.

Government policy now is that employees will not be required to settle their outstanding workers' compensation claims before termination with a voluntary severance package. However, employees retain the option of settlement, should it be preferred.

The policy outlined above will also apply to all future voluntary severances being effected throughout Government.
