2011 REGIONAL QUEEN'S BIRTHDAY PUBLIC HOLIDAY DATES

This year, the Queen's Birthday public holiday in Western Australian is fixed as Friday 28 October.

Section 8(1) of the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1972* enables the Governor to proclaim alternative public holiday dates either throughout the State or within a particular district.

The following alternative dates have been proclaimed to observe the Queen's Birthday public holiday within the district and locality specified.

Local Government Authority	Alternative Date	Area Affected
Town of Port Hedland	Monday, 1 August 2011 Port Hedland Cup Day	The area comprising the town of Port Hedland.
Shire of Roebourne	Monday, 1 August 2011 Community Festival (FeNaCING)	The area comprising the shire of Roebourne.
Shire of East Pilbara	Monday, 4 July 2011 Annual Marble Bar Cup Race Day	The area comprising the town of Marble Bar and within 150km of the town (including the town of Nullagine).
Shire of East Pilbara	Monday, 22 August 2011 Annual Fortescue Festival	The area comprising the town of Newman and within 150km of the town.

These alternative dates are in lieu of Friday 28 October. Within the district and locality specified, 28 October will be regarded as an ordinary working day and the alternative date will be regarded as the Queen's Birthday public holiday for 2011.
