



Circular 8/2020 – Alternative Queen’s Birthday Public Holiday Dates for Specified Regions

The Queen’s Birthday public holiday will generally be observed on Monday 28 September 2020 in Western Australia.

Notwithstanding, section 8(1) of the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1972* (WA) allows the Governor to declare alternative public holidays in specific regions.

The following alternative dates have been published in the *Government Gazette No. 63 of 2020* as alternative Queen’s Birthday public holidays in 2020:

Specified region	Alternative Date	Area Affected
Town of Port Hedland	Monday 3 August 2020	The Port Hedland local government district.
City of Karratha	Monday 3 August 2020	The Karratha local government district.
Shire of East Pilbara – Marble Bar	Monday 6 July 2020	The part of the East Pilbara local government district that is in, or within 150km of, the townsite of Marble Bar including the townsite of Nullagine but not within 150km of the townsite of Newman.
Shire of East Pilbara – Newman	Monday 17 August 2020	The part of the East Pilbara local government district that is in, or within 150km of, the townsite of Newman.

For employment purposes, Monday 28 September 2020 will be regarded as an ordinary working day within each specified region.
